- (viii) Measure the length and breadth of each window in meter, draw the figure also.
- (ix) Calculate area of each window in square meter.
- (x) Subtract the area of door and window from the wall.

1. Two numbers are in the ratio 7:5. If they differ by 16, what are the numbers?
2. The denominator of a rational number is greater than its numerator by 10, if numerator is increased by 19 and denominator is decreased by 1, the number obtained is $\frac{3}{2}$. Find the rational number.
3. The sum of three consecutive multiples of 5 is 330. Find numbers.
4. Three consecutive integers are such that when they are taken in increasing order and multiplied by 3, 4 and 5 respectively, they add up to 386. Find these numbers.
5. One of the two digits of a two digit number is twice the other digit. If you interchange the digits of their two digit number and add the resulting number to the original number you get 66. What is original number?

6. The perimeter of a rectangular swimming pool is 188 meter. Its length is 4 meter more than twice its breadth. What are the length and breadth of pool?
7. The ages of Anjali and Malti are in the ratio 3:4. 8 years later the sum of their ages will be 44 years. What are the present ages.
8. The ages of Astha and Nirmal are in the ratio 5:6. Five years from now their ages will be 6:7. Find their present ages.
9. Vikas's mother is 22 year younger than Vikas's grandmother and 27 year older than vikas's the sum of their ages is 121 years. Find their present ages.
10. One angle of a triangle is equal to the sum of the other two angles. If the ratio of other two angles are 7:8. Find the angles of the triangle.
11. The length of a parallelogram exceeds its breadth by 30 cm. If the perimeter of the parallelogram is 2m 60 cm. Find length and breadth of parallelogram.
12. Two sides of a parallelogram are in the ratio 3:4. If its perimeter is 42 cm. Find length of its sides.
13. Two adjacent angles of a parallelogram are in the ratio 5:7. Find the measures of all the angles.
14. The length of a rectangular is 12 cm and each of its diagonal is 15 cm. Find breadth.
15. ABCD is a rhombus where diagonals intersects at O. If AB = 10 cm, diagonal BD =16 cm. Find length of AC.
