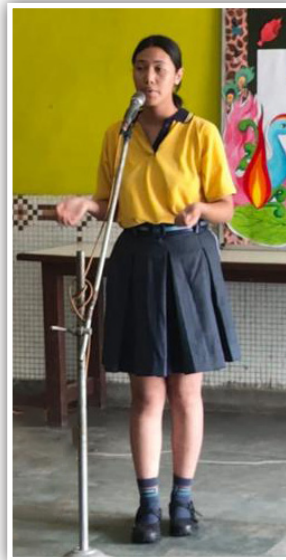

# FUN FILLED EXCURSION TO JIM CORBETT PARK

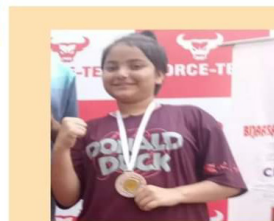

"Spelling is important because it aids in reading. It helps cement the connection that is shared between sounds and letters."

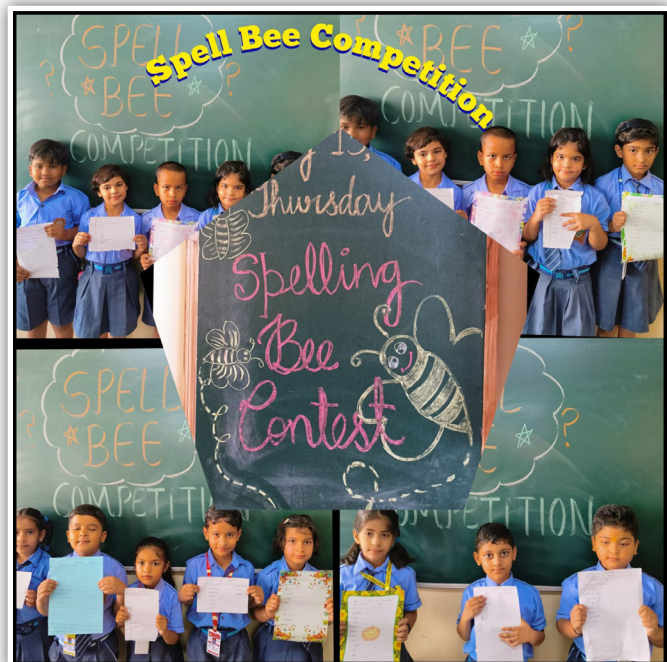
